ROUND-I (Screening)

- Each team must have 3 members from the same college.
- A Preliminary screening round* will be an MCQ-based pen-paper test on Feb 6, 2025.
- Questions will be based on past IPL tournaments.

- The results of Round I will be intimated by lunch.
- The duration of the round will be 20 minutes.
- There will be no negative marking for wrong answers.

ROUND-II The Selection must be made keeping in mind the following requisites:

- From a college, a max. of two teams will be allowed to compete in Round II.

- Each cricket team should consist of
- 3-4 Batsmen
- 3-4 Bowlers

- Any team that exhausts its funds without completing the player's criterion will be disqualified.
